

The American Recovery and Reinvestment Tax Act of 2009, signed on February 17th, extended and modified the tax credits for windows, doors, and skylights established in the Energy Policy Act of 2005.

Qualifying products purchased between January 1, 2009 and December 31, 2010 are eligible for a tax credit equal to 30% of the product cost - installation is not included. The maximum amount of homeowner credit for all improvements combined (including roofing, insulation, HVAC, and water heaters) is \$1,500 during 2009 and 2010.

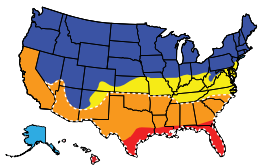
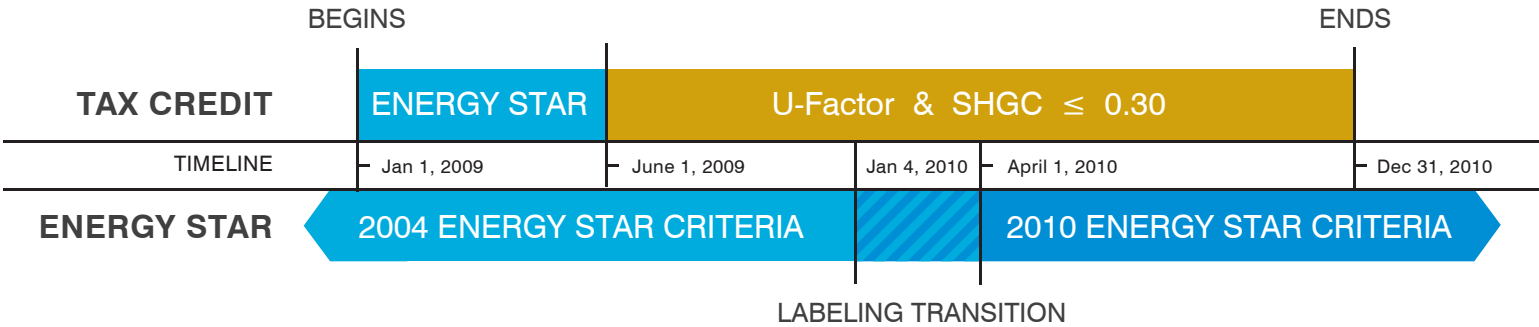
**Must be an existing home & your principal residence. New construction and rentals do not qualify.**

**Purchased January 1, 2009 - June 1, 2009**

- Requirements:** ENERGY STAR Products
- Documentation:** ENERGY STAR label or Manufacturer's Certified Statement
- Products:** All CrystaLite standard stock glass skylights and select plastic domes

**Purchased June 1, 2009 - December 31, 2010**

- Requirements:** NFRC Rated products with U-factor and Solar Heat Gain Coefficient (SHGC) ≤ 0.30
- Documentation:** Manufacturer's Certified Statement
- Products:** CrystaLite ES Skylight, select Custom Frame Configurations, and select Tubular Skylights
